ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Kolbe Academy College Prep Track - 28 credits

Minnesota Standard Track - 21.5 credits

Electives requirement is 6 credits - 5 must be academic electives, 1 may be non-academic.

Physical Education requirement is 2 credits to be fulfilled outside of Mater Dei (four hours per week during one semester fulfills .5 credit requirement).

Foreign Language requirement is 2 credits in the same language - Mater Dei offers 1 credit Foreign Language at this time (Ecclesiastical Latin).

Minnesota Department of Education requires minimum of 21.5 credits for high school graduation including 4 credits language arts, 3.5 credits social studies, 3 credits mathematics, 3 credits science, 1 credit art, 7 credits electives.

Minnesota Homeschool Law has no specific credit requirement, but students must be educated in the areas of reading, writing, literature, fine arts, mathematics, science, history, geography, economics, government, citizenship, health, and physical education.
