Code of Conduct Policy

Participants in the Mater Dei education program are expected to behave in a kind and respectful manner to Mater Dei instructors, staff and peers and to obey the adults in authority. Participants are expected to act in accordance with Christian principles and show respect for the Catholic faith and traditions. Physically or verbally aggressive behavior toward any adult or student will not be tolerated. Disruptive behavior in the Mater Dei education center and/or while participating in any Mater Dei Apostolate activity will not be tolerated. Violations will be handled as follows:

- If two violations occur, Mater Dei Apostolate administration will call the parent/guardian to inform them and solicit possible solutions
- If there is a third violation, the parent/guardian will be called to remove the student from the group for the day.
- Continued violations may result in the student's loss of privilege to participate in one or more courses or activities in the Mater Dei education program.
- Continued violations and/or those of serious matter, as determined by Mater Dei Apostolate administration, will result in the student's loss of privilege to participate in the Mater Dei education program.
